With its introduction as the third language, it will improve teaching and learning of other subjects as well in the schools. This will also help in improving quality dimensions and will equip them with better and improved content-knowledge and pedagogical support while translating their goals in life.

Keeping in view the immediate need of it, the SCERT had been entrusted with the tasks of vetting and coordinating in the development of these books of third language. These books have been the outcomes of hard work by the Book Development Committee of different tribes as well as the Apex Body members of concerned tribes. The credit also goes to the Member Coordinators and the Editors who strived hard to give shape to the books as they are available before us now.

I am sure these books of third languages will meet the challenges in updating learners' ability and will prove immensely effective and helpful in transacting and learning the content. Additionally, SCERT welcomes all suggestions to improve the book for its further editions.

In writing Galo language, the punctuation marks applied in using of 'comma', 'pull stop' etc. and special characters may be continued as per conventional method. Also in writing Galo Language, the use of Capital Letters in proper nouns and in the beginning of a sentence may be continued.

Galo language has many dialects and all Galo dialects are perfectly intelligible to each other, therefore, Lessons of all dialects have been incorporated in the text book. Teachers are advised to make the students familiar to all dialects of Galo language

The exercises in this text book may contain only few dialects of Galo language; therefore, teachers are advised to do needful changes in respect of the local dialect to enable students understand the questions. Further, teachers are advised to help students answer questions in the local dialect only.

How to read and write tones:

In the teaching of tones, the 'contour' of tones may shift in a word in different dialects of Galo language or the 'contour' of tones in the words may shift while being used in sentences within a dialect itself. Therefore, teachers are advised help students write sentences in the local dialect with tones akin to the local dialect only.
